

7.1.9 - Sensitization of students and employees of the Institution to the constitutional obligations: values, rights, duties and responsibilities of citizens

On these occasions, the Principal addresses the gathering and inspires students and staff by informing them about the qualities of freedom fighters, and emphasizing the duties and responsibilities of citizens. NCC and NSS volunteers exhibit the Gaurd of honour to the Principal, staff members and guests to show the discipline and respect to the head of the institution.

The college establishes policies that reflect core values. Code of conduct is prepared for students and staff, and everyone should obey the conduct rules. The institution encourages participation of students in Sports and Games, NCC and NSS at National level to strengthen nationwide bond and relation. The institution takes pride of raising up successful leaders among the students by selecting students on the bases of their results as student representatives for Science Association, different study circles, and the College Miscellany. However, student representatives are selected as—secretaries in different department of Gymkhana based on their proficiency in the respective sports events (as per the bylaws of College Gymkhana). The selected student representatives are given the oath to be abide by the rules and regulations, in order to maintain dignity and decorum of the institution as mentioned in the bylaws of Gymkhana.
